

Dear Members,

We would like to seek the cooperation and support from all our members and guests in implementing the various precautionary measures so that collectively we can make our premises a safer place for enjoyment and relaxation by all as well as contribute our efforts towards combatting the COVID-19 Pandemic.

1. Temperature checks for all entering the premises

All entering the premises will be required to have their temperatures taken. A person with temperature higher than 37.5 °C will not be permitted to enter into the premises.

2. Travel and Health Declaration – Members & Guests

All members and guests will have to fill up the Travel and Health Declaration Form at the point of entry for every visit.

For those driving into the carpark, the security guard at main gate will pass you the form and you are requested to fill up the form after you have parked your car and return it to the security guard at the main entrance.

A Member or guest is cleared for entry into the premises if he/she:

- a. has not travelled recently to any of the countries as listed in the latest and most up to date MOH advisory
- b. is not serving any Stay Home Notice (SHN)
- c. does not have close contact with any COVID-19 infected person
- d. is not having the symptoms of fever, cough, sore throat, body aches, headaches, running nose, tiredness, short of breath or any respiratory sicknesses

3. Hygiene at the Clubhouse & shuttle bus

Common areas and contact surfaces, such as doors and handles, hand railings, etc are disinfected with increased frequency.

Microphones at Karaoke Rooms and mahjong tiles at Mahjong Rooms will also undergo disinfecting before and after use.

Hand sanitizers have been placed at strategic locations within the clubhouse for easy reach by all.

Seats and handrails on the shuttle bus will be disinfected each day with appropriate frequency.

4. Social distancing at events/activities

We will encourage social distancing at events/activities by implementing measures such as wider gaps between seats as well as switching to bigger and more ventilated rooms for bigger size gathering wherever possible.

5. Health of staff

All JAS staff are required to take their temperatures 2 times a day to ensure that they are in good health. They are also refrained from travelling overseas during the period.
