

SECURITY & CLUBHOUSE PERMISSIONS

Basement parking space is exclusively for the use of JAS Members. If you are attending a Japanese language course and wish to use the parking space, please tick the box on the application form and indicate your vehicle number. You can only park during lessons.

JAS clubhouse facilities are only open to Individual Members of the Association & their Guests. Non-member JLC Students are not permitted to enter or utilize facilities in the clubhouse apart from their Classrooms, Restrooms, Club Shop & Waiting Areas, unless accompanied by a JAS Member as a Guest of the Association.

Only JLC Students are permitted entry into JAS premises. Family members and significant others are **Not Allowed** to accompany students into/wait for them in the Clubhouse of premises. Any drop-off or pick-up by vehicle must be done promptly. Strictly no waiting of vehicles is allowed at the porch. **NO SMOKING in the clubhouse.** Smoking is only allowed **at the designated area** beside the porch.
