Licensing conditions for temporary fair food stall

S/n	Licensing conditions
1	This licence is issued in accordance with and subject to the Environmental Public Health Act (Chapter 95) ("the Act") and its Regulations, and shall remain valid for the duration of the licence, unless cancelled prior thereto by the Director-General, Food Administration in accordance with the Act or its Regulations, or the conditions herein.
2	Unless stated otherwise or the context otherwise requires, all terms shall have the same meanings as used in the Act and its Regulations.
3	The licensee hereby represents and warrants that the information and/or documents furnished and supplied for the purposes of applying for this licence are true and accurate
4	This licence is issued on condition that the licensee takes all actions, fulfils all conditions and does all things required to be done (including the obtaining of any necessary consents from the relevant government authorities and other relevant parties), in order to enable it to lawfully enter into, perform and comply with its obligations under this permit.
5	The licensee shall occupy the location as stated in this licence. The Director-General, Food Administration shall be entitled to revoke the licence in the event the licensee ceases to occupy the location as stated in this licence.
6	In the event that the licensee and/or his employee or assistant in the course of his business or in the scope of his employment, is being investigated for any contravention of the Sale of Food Act (Chapter 283) or its Regulations, or the Act or its Regulations for which the licence was issued, Director-General, Food Administration shall be entitled to suspend the licence immediately.
7	In the event the licensee is convicted of any offence of the Sale of Food Act (Chapter 283) or its Regulations, or the Act or its Regulations made thereunder, Director-General, Food Administration shall be entitled to revoke the licence immediately.
8	The licence shall be liable to suspension or cancellation at any time without compensation and without prior notice by the Director-General, Food Administration upon breach of any restriction or condition subject to which it was issued or upon contravention of any of the provisions of the Act or its Regulations made thereunder.
9	This licence is not transferable except with the prior written approval of the Director-General, Food Administration, approval of which may or may not be granted.
10	The licensee shall comply with the Act and its Regulations and any direction, notification or order which the Director-General, Food Administration may, from time to time, issue. Failure to comply with the Act and its Regulations and/or any direction, notification or order shall constitute a breach of the condition of the licence.
11	The name list of foodhandlers, endorsed by Director-General, Food Administration, must be displayed prominent together with the licence in front of the foodstall during the duration of the trade fair
12	Refuse shall not be stored overnight at the site
13	Light preparation of food is permitted, only with supporting facilities, which includes washing facilities (sink connected to clean piped water supply and waste water discharge), storage with temperature control and display showcases for food items.

14	Processing and preparation of raw food such as degutting of fish and cutting of raw meat or vegetable shall not be allowed on site
15	Only food items that has been declared and approved by SFA shall be sold at the foodstall
16	Charcoal grilling is prohibited. Only electric griller shall be used for grilling of food items
17	All self-employed persons are required by law to contribute to Medisave. Please ensure that your Medisave contributions are paid to 31st December of the previous year before applying/renewing your licence. Your payment should be made at least one week before you apply/renew your licence.
18	All personnel engaged in the sale and preparation for sale of food and drinks must wear masks or other forms of physical barrier.
